

Projects – flower garland



Products used

Pattern paper - Heidi's garden
Pattern paper – Panama Lounge
Stainless Steel Scissors
Embroidery thread

Step one

Cut the 4 large glittered flower shapes from the Heidi's garden paper pack. Flip one of the shapes over and use it as a template to cut four more flowers from coordinating papers.

Step two

Place two flowers on top of each other with the petals showing alternate colours.

Step three

Thread a matching embroidery thread through both flowers. Knot the thread in the centre front to make a stamen. Knot at the back to secure the two flowers together.

Step four

Cut a number of small rectangles 1.5cm x 4cm from a striped paper lace page. Trim one end to make a flag shape.

Step 5

Punch two small holes through all of the flags and flowers with a needle at even spacings. Thread the pieces from the back to the front starting with 3 flags then a flower and continue to make a pretty garland for your shelf.
